Agency Postponed Improvements Flexibility

Truist Bank (Truist) announces a new flexibility for postponed improvements and completion escrow account requirements for certain Agency non-AUS and Desktop Underwriter® (DU®) loans.

Effective Dates

Effective for existing and new loan applications on or after October 10, 2025.

Background Information

Truist will permit lenders to waive the completion escrow account requirement for postponed improvements when certain conditions are met. Truist has evaluated this flexibility and is publishing the guidance in our Agency loan standard.

Bulletin Details

Agency Postponed Improvements

Truist will permit lenders to waive a completion escrow account for Agency loan types when certain conditions are met. Eligible transactions include non-AUS and DU 1-unit primary residences and DU second homes, purchase transactions only.

Lenders will not be required to establish a completion escrow account for Postponed Improvements that meet the following requirements:

- the Postponed Improvements are related to inclement weather or a shortage of building materials; and
- the cost to complete such Postponed Improvements does not exceed the lesser of \$12,000 and 2.00% of the "as completed" appraised value of the mortgaged property.

Use SFC 263 to identify loans originated in accordance with the above completion escrow waiver requirements.
